

## Major Employers

The top four employers include 19 Wing CFB Comox with over 1430 employees, School District 71 with over 1400 employees, St. Josephs Hospital with over 1049 employees and Mt. Washington Ski Resort with over 950 employees in the winter months.

The top three retail employers include the Real Canadian Superstore with over 300 employees, Wal-Mart with 218 employees and Home depot with 120 employees. These top three major retail employers account for almost 650 jobs for the Comox Valley.

The top three tourism employers include Mt. Washington Alpine Resort with 950 winter staff, Crown Isle with 150 staff, and the King Fisher Resort with 209 employees respectively.

The top six public sector employers include: the CFB Comox with over 1430 employees, School District 71 with over 1400 employees, St. Joseph's Hospital with 1049 employees, 466 employees at North Island College, 300 at the City of Courtenay and 90 with the Local RCMP. These public sector employers account for over 4,000 jobs in the Comox Valley.
